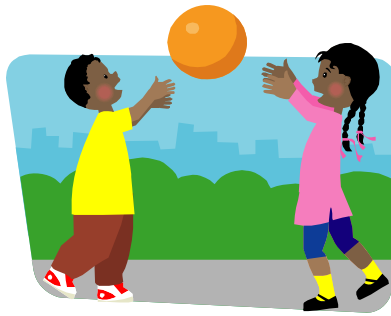


# Kirktonholme Nursery @ Wellshot Road
